Reminder: Even though Conditions Say for Racing Sat or Sun these conditions are for the entire weekend. Once the races fill we will allocate the days they will run.

the STARTER ALLOWANCE SERIES - it is NOT a stake race.

Please make sure you are entering for the correct weekend of racing.

Entries on TUESDAYS prior to the race weekend entries open at 7:30am - races called off 10:00 - close entries by 10:30am for the entire weekend

Draws WEDNESDAYS - 10:15am

RMTC will be putting out **one condition sheet** for racing each weekend (Even though conditions say to race Fri. Sat. Sun. or Mon, it is for racing the entire weekend. Days will be allocated after entries.

Xpressbet accounts can be opened check with race office or simulcast.

HORSE REGISTRATION PAPERS MUST be in the race office prior to entering for the weekend.

DIGITAL HORS PAPERS MUST be transferred to the race office in LETHBRIDGE prior to entry day and must have correct owner/trainer

REMINDER: Make sure that your digital Horse Papers are sent to the race track in LETHBRIDGE Ask the race secretary at the track to transfer them before you leave the track.

Horsemen's Cheque request must be in the request book in the Race Office, Sunday by 4:30pm and will ready by the following Friday. Horsemen owner cheques will be done **ONCE a week.**

- Horsemen Cheques must be requested half hour after last race on Sundays (or Holiday Monday)

PREFERENCES DATE

- A horse that has been entered at the meet will have an Entry Date that will be recognized for any condition
- Horses that run will receive a running date corresponding to the "**WEEKEND** OF" that they run and lose the date previously held.
- **Gate Approvals: (Check with race office) They will be posted by the race office To be approved Horse papers must be in the office horse papers area only accepted in race office if the horse is tattooed..**
- **Race Days, Sat. Sun. Mon. race track is closed at 9:30am. Other days at 11:30am**
- **FOR ALL STAKE RACES AND ALL RACES HOUSE SILKS MUST BE WORN.**

IF YOU HAVE AN **ALTERNATE RACE** PLEASE PUT ON IT ON YOUR ENTRY SLIP AT YOUR TIME OF ENTRY.
No horses will be transferred to an alternate race unless the Original race is called off.

NOTE: ENTRIES WILL ONLY be taken by entering in person at the race office or by talking directly to an entry clerk. NO entries will be taken by leaving a voicemail, or fax, or email, or text.

SEE THE RACE OFFICE FOR ALL RMTc POLICIES and FIRE EVACUATION PROCEDURES.

Only trainers are permitted in the race office to enter horses and trainers/jockeys to be at draws.

TIMED WORKS

Horses must have a qualified work within 45 days for Mixed races (5 ½ Fur or less or 6 Fur or farther 30 days prior to entering.) A Timed Work form must be filled out by the trainer and given to the clocker at the back gate by the Blue Barn before the horse goes on the track for the timed work.

Timed works weather permitting will be announced. From **8:00am to 9:00am**

Gate approvals, weather permitting Please contact the race office for gate approvals.

Fill out the timed work sheets for timed works and timed gate works and give to the clocker.

VET CHECKS ON RACE DAYS

Reminder all horses must be on the grounds before 10:00am on race days for vet checks.

TAKE ENTRY SLIPS AND FILL THEM OUT THEN DROP THEM OFF EARLY IN THE MORNING IF YOU ARE NOT ABLE TO COME AND ENTER EARLY ON ENTRY DAY!

When parking horse trailers in the jockey parking lot park within 3 feet of the last one parked.

NO PUTTING OF MANURE AROUND THE WALKERS PUT IN THE MANURE BINS.

TURN OFF LIGHTS IN THE BARNs WHEN YOU ARE NOT IN THE BARN AND ALSO AT NIGHT

ALL RIDERS ON THE RACE TRACK NEED TO WEAR A HELMET & FLACK JACKET.

NOTE: FOR THE ALBERTA BRED STAKES READ THE PREFERENCES FOR ALBERTA BRED STAKES! NOT THE PREFERENCES FOR "B" CUP RACES. (Alberta Bred stakes do not have to have 3 starts on a "B" track.

For the STARTER ALLOWANCE SERIES we will be writing a FILLIES AND MARES STARTER ALLOWANCE SERIES

2nd leg at 6 Furlongs will be the fourth weekend

3rd leg at 7 furlongs will be the sixth weekend

Purses \$7,000 added same preferences.

"B" CUP STAKES

- **For horses that have run at Alberta "B" tracks, Lethbridge, Millarville, Grande Prairie**
 - A horse **must** have at least 3 starts on a "B" track in Alberta in 2022 of which 2 starts must be at RMTC then the preferences below apply.
 - 2 year olds must have 1 start on a "B" track in Alberta **OR** have been entered a minimum of 2 times **at RMTC** and the race did not fill (this applies only to 2 year olds for "B" Cup Stakes). Then the preferences below apply. #5 & 6 does not apply for Fall stakes
 - "B" Tracks include Lethbridge Spring & Fall meets, Millarville and Grande Prairie
- NOTE: The 3 starts on a "B" track applies only to the "B" Cup Stake.**

PREFERENCES

1. Winner in a Stake Race in 2022
2. Placed 2nd in a Stake Race in 2022
3. Placed 3rd in a Stake Race in 2022
4. Winner in an Open Allowance Race in 2022
5. **Placed 2nd in an Open Allowance Race in 2022****
6. **Placed 3rd in an Open Allowance Race in 2022****
7. Winner of an Open Claiming Race in 2022 (highest claiming price preferred)
8. RMTC starters in 2022 preferred
 - RMTC placed starters in 2022 preferred first if both horses have same preference.
Eg) Both horses have won an open allowance race, the winner at RMTC will be preferred over the other horse. This preference will be considered before the year earnings. Earnings are determined by the Incompass Equibase data reportings.
 - Horses with equal preference, starters will be determined based on Equibase reported earnings.
 - Races considered Stakes are if total purse money is **\$10,000 or more.**
 - Any Stake for less than **\$10,000** will be considered an Open Allowance race.
An Open Allowance must be a race that is open with no conditions or restriction.
 - If the purse is less than **\$5,600** it will be considered a Claiming race. The total purse will then become a claiming price for the preference. Eg, The purse total of **\$3,200** would then be an Open Claiming \$3,200.
 - To be considered a STAKE race, the condition must be OPEN (Exception would be Alberta Bred Stake races, "B" Cup Stake races, ACTRA Alberta Bred Stake races) as long as the total purse is \$10,000+
 - Thoroughbred Stakes are open **only** to Thoroughbred horses.
 - **Money earned in MAIDEN races is not considered for Stake races. This does not apply to 2 yr olds**
